Her parents are immigrant refugees, and she is the first person in her family (out of 8 siblings) to earn a Bachelor's degree (SSU) in American Multicultural Studies and a Master's degree in Higher Education and Student Affairs (Indiana State U). She has worked within the CA State University system for 10 years, and has been at SSU since 2012. Her background in student leadership development also includes holistic advising which focuses on the whole student. Yang-Vigil lives with her husband and 3 beautiful children in Sonoma County.


